Heat resistant wigs can withstand heated styling tools at moderate temperatures without damaging the fibres. #### **How to wash a synthetic wig**

Tips for washing your wig and keeping your wig looking beautiful much longer. Avoid stretching or damaging the cap. How to deal with tangles, matting, shedding and restoring shine.

#### **Detangling**

Before washing, make sure to gently detangle the hair with your fingers or a wide tooth comb. Work your way from the ends to the roots to reduce shedding.

#### **Rinsing**

Rinse from the roots to the end with lukewarm running water. Let the water flow from the roots to the ends of your hair.

#### **Shampooing**

Put a walnut size amount of shampoo in your hand and work your way through the hair, in a downwards motion from the roots, to the tips of the hair. Rinse once until the water runs clear. Blot out excess water with a towel. Avoid twisting or wringing.

#### **Conditioning**

Spray leave-in conditioner from the middle of the shaft to the ends, avoiding the roots or knots.

**Drying**

Air dry on a wig stand, the wig will return to its original style.
