Machine made wigs are less expensive because they can be mass produced very quickly. They also have more volume and lift due to the thickness of the cap. They can look very realistic when the hair falls in the way its sewn.

Synthetic Wigs

These wigs are great, because they are very easy to maintain. All you should do is wash the unit after about 30 wears, or every four weeks with the shampoo special formulated for the wig, towel blot and spray with a silicone conditioner, let it air dry and its ready to wear again! The conditioner should be use regularly to keep the wig soft and bring out the shine and flexibility of the fibre.

How to wash a synthetic wig

Tips for washing your wig and keeping your wig looking it's better for much longer. Avoid stretching or damaging the cap. Dealing with tangles, matting, hair loss and restoring shine.

Disentanglement

Before washing, make sure to gently detangle the hair with your fingers or a wide-tooth comb. Work your way from the ends to the roots to reduce hair loss.

Rinsing

Rinse from the roots to the end with running lukewarm water. Let the water flow from the roots to the tips of your hair.

Hair wash

Take a walnut-sized amount of shampoo and work your way through the hair in a downward motion from the roots to the ends of the hair. Rinse until the water runs clear. Dab off excess water with a towel. Avoid twisting or wringing it out.

Conditioning

Spray the leave-in conditioner from the middle of the shaft to the ends, avoiding roots or knots.

Drying

Air dry the wig on a wig stand, the wig will return to its original style.
